Option 2 – if you do not have Photo ID


Contact your GP practice. You need to ask them for 3 registration detail


- 1. Linkage Key (could be called a Passphrase)

- 3. Account ID


You can use these 3 registration details to prove who you are

- You can access someone else's records if you have permission to do so.










Most patients will automatically be given access from February 2023 onwards. If you would like to view data prior to this, please speak to your local surgery team.

 You can view your test results carried out by your GP surgery if you have been given access to your detailed coded record (ask your local surgery if you are unsure)











Nominate a pharmacy


- You can choose where to collect your prescription after it has been issued by GP this is called a nominated pharmacy.

- 1. Select 'View and manage prescriptions'










Manage the health record on behalf of a spouse, child, parent or someone else you care for


- This access needs to be granted by the surgery and there are rules we follow closely when granting

4. Orange bar tells you who you're managing on behalf of






